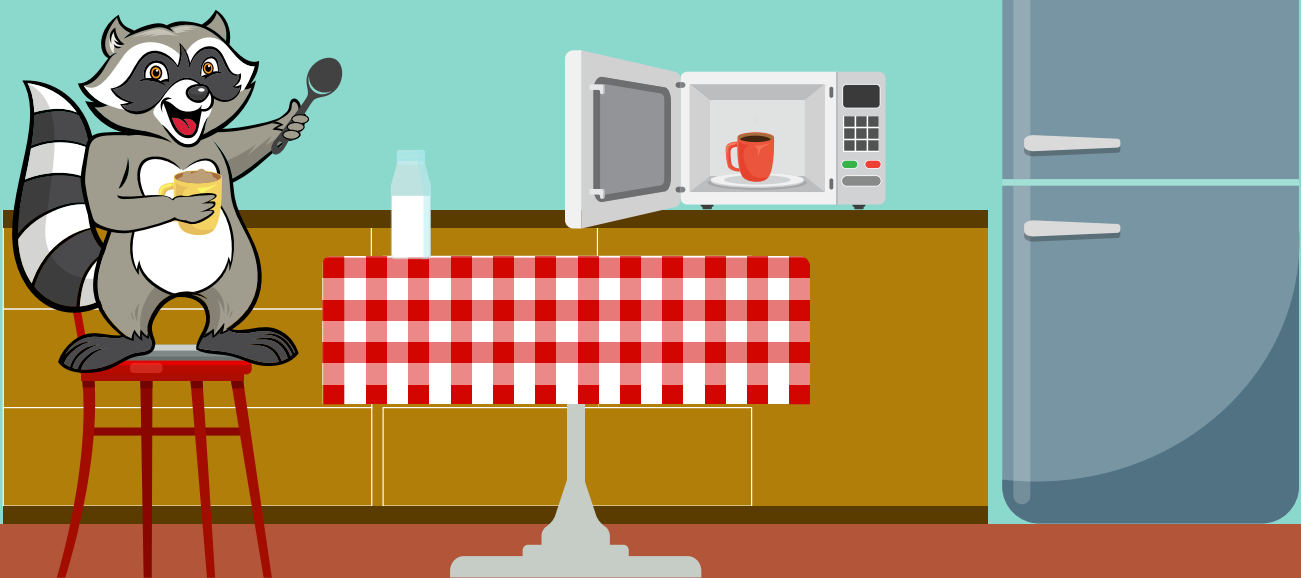

Zap Snack Mug Cake

1. Find your favorite coffee mug and a tablespoon.
2. Using the tablespoon, put three tablespoons of your favorite cake flavor mix in the mug.
3. Put two tablespoons of your favorite soda flavor in the mug.
4. Mix together slowly.
5. Place the mug in the microwave and microwave for one minute.
6. After one minute, check the mixture to see if cooked.
7. If the cake is not fully cooked, microwave in 15-second increments until fully cooked. Be sure not to overcook!
8. Add your favorite toppings such as sprinkles, chocolate chips, or whipped cream and enjoy!
