



CAMP CRAFT: Painting Fireworks

This week we're celebrating our nation's Independence Day, while learning about firework and electrical safety in our Camp Save-a-Watt video. For our activity we'll be painting fireworks! As you're painting, use your imagination and remember that since fireworks come in all shapes and sizes, there's no wrong way to paint!



Supplies needed:

- Washable finger paint
- Paper plates or bowls
- Large sheet of white paper
- Toilet paper rolls (2 or more)
- Glitter, sticker, or other small decorative pieces



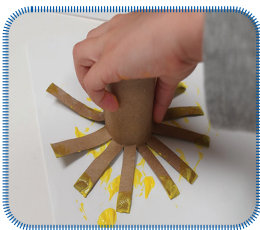

Using safety scissors, cut toilet paper rolls about 2 inches up one side to create "fingers" and spread them out.

With help from an adult, pour a small amount of your favorite color paint into a small plate or bowl. Lightly dip the toilet paper roll into the paint. Use your fingers or paint brush to be sure paint is spread along cut pieces of the roll.

Dip the toilet paper roll in paint, then place it on the paper using a brush-like motion to make fireworks. Continue with different colors, if you like.

If you'd like add stickers, glitter, or other decorative pieces to your fireworks. Just have fun!
